



Those Halcyon days

A heady mix of aristocrats, mistresses and lavish interiors, ITV's latest Sunday-night drama, *The Halcyon*, has been dubbed "Downtown Abbey in a hotel". The series, starring **Kara Tointon** and **Olivia Williams**, is set in wartime London and an early scene showed the fictional hotel at 32 Lincoln's Inn Fields, near the Royal Courts of Justice, being hit by a bomb. A neighbouring plot, Lincoln Square, can no longer be described as a bomb site: a year-long project to convert it into a 10-storey residential development has finished. Properties there range from studios to four-bedroom penthouses, and buying in gets you access to a private club, a library, a cinema and a pool, as well as a snooker room and a dining room.
